ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: April 13, 2022 Effective Date: April 13, 2022

On February 1, 2022, Vicinity Energy, Kansas City, Inc. (Vicinity) filed tariff sheets (Tracking No. YH-2022-0218) to change Vicinity's production adjustment cost clause (PACC) rates for steam service. On March 24, 2022, the Commission rejected Vicinity's proposed tariff sheets, suspended the timeline, and ordered the parties to propose a procedural schedule. On April 6, 2022, Vicinity and the Staff of the Commission timely filed the *Parties' Proposed Procedural Schedule*.

After reviewing the jointly proposed procedural schedule, the Commission concludes that the schedule proposed by the parties is reasonable and should be adopted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

April 29, 2022 Vicinity files substitute proposed tariff sheets and revised Direct Testimony

May 13, 2022 Staff files Rebuttal Testimony, or Recommendation regarding proposed substitute tariff sheets

May 24, 2022 Vicinity files Surrebuttal Testimony, if necessary

¹ If the Office of the Public Counsel wishes to file rebuttal testimony it may do so on May 13, 2022.

May 27, 2022 List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, Order of

Cross Examination, if necessary

June 1, 2022 Position Statements, if necessary

June 6, 2022 Evidentiary Hearing, if necessary

June 23, 2022 Initial Briefs

June 30, 2022 Reply Briefs

2. The parties shall comply with the following procedures:

(a) Testimony shall be prefiled as defined in Commission Rule 20 CSR

4240-2.130, including the requirement that testimony be filed on

line-numbered pages.

(b) Although not all parties may agree upon how each issue should be

described or on whether a listed issue is in fact a proper issue in this case,

the parties shall agree upon and file a list of the issues to be heard, the

witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in which they will

be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of

issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue

that must be resolved. The Commission will view any issue not contained

in this list of issues as not requiring resolution by the Commission.

(c) Each party shall file a simple and concise statement summarizing its

position on each disputed issue. Position statements shall track the list of

issues. Any position statement shall set forth any order requested, cite any

law authorizing that relief, and allege facts relevant under the law with

citations to any pre-filed testimony in support.

(d) All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of

issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

- (e) If testimony or documents are prefiled and served upon the parties before a hearing, a party need only provide an emailed copy of the testimony or document to exhibits@psc.mo.gov. If not prefiled and served upon the parties, then a party who has a document marked for use at the hearing shall email it to the presiding officer, and counsel for each other party, prior to the hearing if possible.
- 3. The hearing, if necessary, shall be held on June 6, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
