NOTICE OF INTENDED CASE FILING

COMES NOW KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO” or “Company”), by and through counsel, and files this Notice of Intended Case Filing. In this regard, GMO respectfully states to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. GMO is a Delaware corporation with its principal office and place of business at 1200 Main Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64105. GMO is primarily engaged in the business of providing electric and steam utility service in Missouri to the public in its certificated areas. GMO is an electrical corporation and public utility as defined in Section 386.020 (2000), as amended. *Id.* A Certificate of Authority for a foreign corporation to do business in the State of Missouri, evidencing the GMO’s authority under the law to conduct business in the State of Missouri, was filed with the Commission in Case No. EU-2002-1053 and is incorporated herein by reference in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G). GMO’s fictitious name registration was filed in Case No. EN-2009-0015 and is incorporated herein by reference.

2. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.017(1) provides, in pertinent part, as follows:

(1) Any person that intends to file a case shall file a notice with the secretary of the commission a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to filing such case. Such notice shall detail the type of case and issues likely to be before the commission and shall include a summary of all communication regarding substantive issues likely to be in the case between the filing party and the office of the commission that occurred in the ninety (90) days prior to filing the notice. The filing of such notice shall initiate a new noticed case and be assigned an appropriate case designation and number. If the expected case filing is subsequently made, it shall be filed in the

noticed case. If the expected case filing is not made within one hundred eighty (180) days, the noticed case shall close.

3. Undersigned counsel is unaware of any Company communications with the office of the Commission regarding this matter.

4. It is GMO's intent to file an application pursuant to Section 393.1075, 4 CSR 240-20.093, 4 CSR 240-20.094, 4 CSR 240-3.163 and 4 CSR 204-3.164 for authority to approve demand-side programs, and authority to establish a Demand-Side Programs Investment Mechanism ("DSIM") that will include, inter alia, cost recovery of demand-side program costs, recovery of a portion of the net shared benefits, lost revenues and an incentive mechanism. The Company may seek a waiver, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-4.017(1)(D) so that it can file the application earlier than 60 days from the date of this notice.

WHEREFORE, GMO submits to the Commission and its Secretary this Notice of Intended Case Filing.
