ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On May 3, 2005, the Commission issued an Order Approving an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge but Rejecting Submitted Tariff. The Order authorized Missouri Gas Energy to file a replacement tariff. The company did so on May 3, 2005, with a request that the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on May 13, 2005.

In light of MGE's request, the Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission to file its memorandum, informing the Commission of whether the replacement tariff is in compliance with the Commission's order and recommending whether the tariff should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file a memorandum as described in the body of this order no later than May 10, 2005.
2. That this order shall become effective on May 4, 2005.
