On June 29, 2006, MGE filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2005, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for mains, valves, service lines, regulator stations, vaults, and other pipeline system components.

As ordered by the Commission, Staff filed its Recommendation on August 28. Staff recommended that the Commission reject MGE's tariff sheets and that MGE replace those sheets with tariff sheets that are consistent with Staff's Recommendation. Staff stated that it found an error of \$2,690 in MGE's deferred income tax calculation.

The Commission will order MGE to state whether it concurs with or objects to Staff's Recommendation.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, shall respond to Staff's Recommendation as ordered above no later than September 8, 2006. 2. This order shall become effective on August 29, 2006.
