ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE REPORT

On October 17, 2007, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (MGE), filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting a change to its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") rate schedule. Section 393.1012.2(2), RSMo Supp. 2006, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265(11) provide that the Staff of the Commission may examine the ISRS filing and submit a report regarding its examination not later than 60 days after the natural gas utility files its petition. The Commission will order Staff to file such a report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a report regarding its examination of Missouri Gas Energy's ISRS filing no later than December 17, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on November 14, 2007.
