## **ORDER GRANTING MIEC'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On November 9, 2007, Laclede Gas Company filed an application seeking to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge. The Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and established December 3 as an intervention deadline.

A group of companies identifying itself as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) applied to intervene on December 3.<sup>1</sup> No party has objected to MIEC's application to intervene.

The Commission finds that the interest of MIEC in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.
