MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT AND APPROVAL OF COMPLIANCE TARIFF FILING

As good cause for approval on less than 30 days' notice, GMO states that these compliance tariff sheets serve to implement an agreement among most of the parties to this proceeding that was opposed by no party to this proceeding, has been approved by the Commission and which will enable GMO to begin recovering a portion of the substantial costs it has expended to comply with Missouri's renewable energy standard.
