NOTICE REGARDING ENTRY OF APPEARANCE ON BEHALF OF UNION LOCAL

Laclede Gas Company filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission on November 9, 2007, requesting implementation of a new Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") rate schedule. The Commission directed that notice of Laclede's petition be given to potentially interested parties and established December 3 as the deadline for filing applications to intervene. On December 3, Michael A. Evans, of the law firm of Hammond, Shinners, Turcotte, Larrew and Young, P.C., filed an Entry of Appearance on behalf of USW Local 11-6. In the signature block of the Entry, Evans identifies himself as attorney for Utility Workers Union of America Local 335, AFL-CIO.

Mr. Evans' filing of an Entry of Appearance is without effect because neither Local 11-6, nor Local 335 is a party to this case and neither has filed an application for leave to intervene. If either union local wants to become a party to this case, it must file an application to intervene in compliance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075. Since the deadline for filing applications to intervene has now passed, if either union

local wants to intervene, it must also show good cause for granting that application after the intervention date.
