ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF, DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE

On July 2, 2010, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission to change its infrastructure system replacement surcharge (ISRS). With its application, the company filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge. Unless the Commission acts to suspend the tariff, it will become effective on August 1, 2010.

The Commission is required¹ to act on the petition within 120 days. Consequently, any order the Commission issues must be effective no later than October 30, 2010. Although the Commission may decide this matter sooner, the Commission will suspend the company's tariff until October 30.

The Commission is also required² to publish notice of the application. To that end, the Commission will require that its Data Center and Information Officer provide notice to those who may be interested. In the ordered paragraphs below, the Commission will set a deadline by which applications to intervene shall be filed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed by Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, and assigned tariff YG-2011-0011, is suspended until October 30, 2010. The tariff sheet suspended is:

P.S.C. MO. No. 1 11th Revised Sheet No. 10, Cancelling 10th Revised Sheet No. 10

2. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall mail a copy of this notice to the County Commission for each of the counties in Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company's service area. The company provides service in the following counties: Andrew, Barry, Barton, Bates, Buchanan, Carroll, Cass, Cedar, Christian, Clay, Clinton, Dade, DeKalb, Greene, Henry, Howard, Jackson, Jasper, Johnson, Lafayette, Lawrence, McDonald, Moniteau, Pettis, Platte, Ray, Saline, Stone, and Vernon.

3. The Information Officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing constituents in Missouri Gas Energy's service area.

4. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than July 26, 2010, and shall be filed with:
