On October 29, 2010, Laclede Gas Company filed an application and petition to establish an infrastructure system replacement surcharge (ISRS), requesting an ISRS revenue increase of \$2,570,494. Laclede's application was accompanied by an implementing tariff bearing an effective date of January 5, 2011. On December 15, 2010, Laclede extended the tariff effective date to January 7, 2011.

On December 28, 2010, the Commission's Staff filed its Recommendation. Staff recommends rejection of Laclede's tariff based upon its determination that the appropriate revenue requirement is pre-tax revenues of \$2,490,876 annually.

Because of the fast-approaching tariff effective date, the Commission will shorten the deadline for responses to Staff's Recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Responses to Staff's Recommendation shall be filed no later than 12:00 p.m. on Monday, January 3, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
