**ORDER SEPARATING COMPLAINT**

On January 28, 2010, Ag Processing, Inc., filed a complaint<sup>1</sup> against KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, f/k/a Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks-L&P. The complaint consists of two counts related to the two annual rate adjustment periods for the Quarterly Cost Adjustment (QCA) mechanism for steam fuel costs. These two rate adjustment periods are for calendar years 2006 and 2007 and correspond to the two case numbers captioned above.

After consulting with the parties to this matter, it has been determined that the complaint should be separated from the QCA cases. Therefore the issues regarding the complaint shall be heard in Case No. HC-2010-0235.
