On June 17, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed tariffs which purport to comply with the Commission's Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing issued on June 10, 2009. The Commission would be aided by a recommendation from its Staff regarding the tariff sheets and will direct that the recommendation be filed as set out below.

The tariffs were filed, as directed by the Commission, with an effective date of July 1, 2009. The Commission previously found that good cause exists to approve tariffs which comply with the Commission's order with less than 30 days notice. Therefore, the Commission will shorten the time for responses so that it may take up the tariffs on its regularly scheduled agenda prior to July 1, 2009.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the compliance tariffs no later than June 22, 2009.
- 2. Any other responses to the tariffs, or the recommendation of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall be filed no later than June 23, 2009.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
