The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting *Kansas City Power & Light Company's Motion for Extension of Time* ("motion").<sup>1</sup> In the motion, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") asks the Commission to extend the due date for filing KCP&L's direct testimony on the revenue requirement to August 26, 2011. In support, KCP&L cites delays and failures in complying with discovery by Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. The discovery dispute now includes an application for rehearing before the Commission and a simultaneous Notice of Appeal in the Missouri Court of Appeals, Western District, on the same ruling. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.

2. The due date for Kansas City Power & Light Company to file its direct testimony on the revenue requirement is extended to August 26, 2011.
