On January 31, 2020, Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. (Veolia) filed tariff sheets (Tracking No. YH-2020-0123) to revise its Production Adjustment Cost Clause (PACC) rates for steam service. The tariff sheets have a proposed effective date of April 1, 2020. The Commission directed notice of the PACC filing, directed the Commissions' Staff to file a recommendation, and set a deadline for intervention. On March 5, Staff filed its recommendation to approve the tariff sheets. Therein, Staff recommended approval of two tariff sheets:

P.S.C. MO. No. 1

6th Revised Sheet No. 36, Cancelling 5th Revised Sheet No. 36 6th Revised Sheet No. 37, Cancelling 5th Revised Sheet No. 37 (sic)

The Commission finds that Veolia has filed no tariff sheet designated 6th Revised Sheet No. 37, cancelling 5th Revised Sheet No. 37 in this file. Instead, Veolia has filed a tariff sheet designated "5th Revised Sheet No. 37, cancelling 4th Revised Sheet No. 37." The Commission notices, further, that on March 20, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Approving Rider Energy Efficiency Investment Charge Tariff Sheet, which also approved "5th Revised Sheet No. 37 Cancelling 4th Revised Sheet No. 37," effective April 1, 2019.²

The Commission finds the Commission Staff has recommended approval of a tariff sheet with a different designation than any filed by Veolia and that Veolia has filed a tariff sheet with a different designation from any approved by the Staff. The Commission will order the parties to confer and file a recommendation or other appropriate pleadings.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than noon on March 9, 2020, the parties shall confer and file a recommendation or other pleadings concerning Veolia's revised tariff sheets.
- 2. Any party wishing to comment on the tariff sheets or respond to the parties' recommendations or pleadings shall do so no later than March 16, 2020.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
