On December 30, 2020, the Commission issued its Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement Resolving Issues Arising from the City of Kansas City's Change in Sewer Billing (Order). The order required Vicinity Energy Kansas City, Inc. (Vicinity)¹ to file any tariff sheets necessitated by the order or otherwise file pleadings explaining the resulting tariff sheet status. On January 8, 2021, Vicinity filed its response to the order, stating that no new tariff sheets or changes to existing tariffs were required by the order. No objections or responses to Vicinity's response have been filed. The order was effective on January 29, 2021. No further action is required in this file, and this file may be now closed.
