ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On June 29, 2006, MGE filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2005, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for mains, valves, service lines, regulator stations, vaults, and other pipeline system components. On July 3, the Commission set an intervention deadline of July 24. No parties asked to intervene.

Section 393.1015.2(2) states that the Staff of the Commission may file a report regarding an ISRS application no later than 60 days after the petition is filed. The Commission will order Staff to file such a report by the deadline contemplated by the statute.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than August 28, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on July 25, 2006.
