MISSOURI GAS ENERGY'S MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE" or "Company"), a division of Southern Union Company, and for its motion to suspend procedural schedule respectfully states the following:

1. Direct testimony in this consolidated proceeding is presently scheduled to be filed on June 30, 2005, with subsequent events scheduled to occur thereafter. During the week of June 6, 2005, representatives of MGE and the Commission Staff met to discuss the substance of this matter. As a result of those discussions, MGE believes it would be beneficial to suspend the procedural schedule to permit the parties to focus their efforts on the communication and exchange and analysis of information necessary to determine whether settlement is possible.
