2	JUDGE JONES: Good evening. My name is
3	Kennard Jones. I am the regulatory law judge presiding
4	over this rate case. For the record this is in the matter
5	of Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren UE, for the
6	authority to file tariffs increasing the rates for natural
7	gas service provided to customers in the company's Missouri
8	service areas, File No. GR-2010-0363.
9	To my right is one of the five
10	commissioners, Commissioner Terry Jarrett. Commissioner
11	Jarrett, would you like to say anything before we get
12	started?
13	COMMISSIONER JARRETT: Sure. Thank you,
14	Judge. I appreciate you all coming out tonight. As they
15	probably explained to you earlier, there are five
16	commissioners. We're appointed by the governor and
17	approved by the Senate.
18	Unfortunately, we're spread pretty thin
19	right. We have several cases where we're having local
20	public hearings, so commissioners are kind of all over the
21	state attending these. So therefore, don't take it that we
22	don't think these are important just because one
23	commissioner is here. We do take these local public
24	hearings very important you know, we understand they're
25	very important. We'd like to hear your comments and your

1	testimony, and we take it very seriously. So we thank you
2	
3	with that I'll turn it back over to the judge.
4	JUDGE JONES: Okay. We only have two people
5	signed up to testify. I will let you all know that if,
6	after they testify, someone else would like to, you will
7	have an opportunity to do so. So don't think just because
8	you haven't signed up, you don't get to speak on the
9	record. Let's go ahead and get started.
10	And I'm not sure. Is that the microphone
11	they're supposed to use right there?
12	THE COURT REPORTER: If they just stand,
13	I'll be able to hear them.
14	JUDGE JONES: Just stand and talk, you'll be
15	able to hear them.
16	Okay. I'll ask you all to speak clearly and
17	loudly so the court reporter can hear what you're saying.
18	First we have Bob Mitchem. Did I pronounce
19	your last name correctly?
20	MR. MITCHEM: Yes, sir.
21	JUDGE JONES: Okay. Could you please stand
22	so the court reporter can hear you, and spell your last
23	name for her also, please.
24	MR. MITCHEM: My name is Bob Mitchem,
25	M-i-t-c-h-e-m.

LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING 11-29-2010 1 (Witness sworn.) 2 JUDGE JONES: Sir, you may proceed. 3 BOB MITCHEM testified as follows: 4 MR. MITCHEM: Thank you, sir. My comments were for the PSC. I'd like to support them in their 5 6 reducing their request from 10.5 percent to a more 7 reasonable 8 to 9 percent. 8 I had another comment about -- and my mind 9 has gone completely blank and I can't remember what it was. 10 JUDGE JONES: Take your time. 11 MR. MITCHEM: Yes. The -- the residential 12 customer fixed rate of \$15, I'd like to see that left as it is and not changed to \$20.50 fixed rate. That impact would 13 14 be -- that's a 30 percent increase, which seems excessive 15 to me. 16 JUDGE JONES: Okay. Did you have any 17 questions of Mr. Mitchem? 18 COMMISSIONER JARRETT: I don't have any 19 questions, Mr. Mitchem, but I do appreciate your comments. 20 JUDGE JONES: Next we have Sema Thacker. IS there a Thacker here? 21 22 MS. THACKER: NO. 23 JUDGE JONES: You don't want --24 MS. THACKER: No. 25 JUDGE JONES: Okay. Those are the only

persons that have signed up. Is there anyone else who 1 would like to give testimony on the record before we close 2 3 the hearing? 4 I do want to ask you one question, Mr. Mitchem. You said you agree with PSC. Did you mean 5 you agree with the Staff of the PSC and their position 6 7 on --MR. MITCHEM: Yes, sir, the Staff of the 8 9 PSC. JUDGE JONES: All right. Well, with that 10 11 then we will --12 COMMISSIONER JARRETT: I just wanted to add too, I know you've met our Staff here. If you haven't had 13 your questions answered or you have some more questions you 14 want answered, I'm sure our Staff will be around for a 15 little while, so I want you to leave tonight having all 16 17 your questions answered. So please feel free to get with Staff if you have any further questions. 18 19 JUDGE JONES: Okay. Well, with that then, we'll go off the record.
