RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, on behalf of itself and Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) and the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”)(collectively the “Parties”), and states as follows:

1. On June 28, 2017, the Commission issued an *Order Directing Filing* (“Order”) which stated that “the Commission will direct Staff to coordinate with Ameren Missouri and the Office of the Public Counsel, and file with the Commission, a proposed schedule of progress reports, relating to implementing Staff’s recommendations, to be filed under this file number.”

2. The Order further provided that the filing described above shall be due on July 10, 2017.

3. By this filing, the Parties propose that Ameren Missouri file quarterly progress reports relating to its implementation of Staff’s recommendations beginning on the first business day of October 2017, January 2018, April 2018, and July 2018.
