ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES

On October 30, 2020, Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire filed an application and tariffs seeking to establish an on-bill financing program and cost recovery mechanism. The Commission suspended the tariffs until September 29, 2021, and set a procedural schedule including a hearing.

On April 29, 2021, the parties filed a *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* purporting to resolve all the contested issues. On May 11, 2021, Spire filed a motion requesting that Revised Exhibit A (revisions to the proposed compliance tariffs) be approved. Spire indicated that the tariff changes were agreed upon by all the parties, but the motion was only signed by Spire’s counsel.

The Commission will require the other parties to state whether they are in agreement to amending their *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* by including the Revised Exhibit A.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than May 21, 2021, the parties, other than Spire, shall file a response indicating whether they are in agreement with the Revised Exhibit A filed by Spire on May 11, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
