# STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, and for its recommendation to approve Spire's proposed WNAR tariff sheets as filed on Monday, September 20, 2021, states the following:

# Background

- 1. On September 1, 2021, Spire Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West (Spire), filed an application to update its Weather Normalization Rider (WNAR) pursuant to Section 386.266.3 and its Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West tariff Sheets 13 through 13.2. On September 10, Staff recommended rejection of those tariff sheets. Spire filed substitute revised tariff sheets and work papers to remove certain billing errors. The Commission issued a September 21 Order requiring a Staff recommendation on Spire's substituted revised tariff sheets JG-2022-0047 and JG-2022-0048 no later than noon on September 24, 2021.
- 2. As set forth in the attached memorandum, Staff has reviewed Spire's substitute revised WNAR tariff sheets JG-2022-0047 and JG-2022-0048 filed on Monday, September, 20, 2021, and recommends the Commission approve those tariffs sheets with an effective date of October 1, 2021.
- 3. Staff appreciates Spire's willingness to follow Staff's recommendation in this case where Spire has not agreed with all of Staff's assertions.

## **Staff Recommendation**

4. Staff recommends the Commission approve Spire's substitute revised WNAR tariff sheets JG-2022-0047 and JG-2022-0048 as filed on Monday, September 20, 2021.

**WHEREFORE**, as set forth in Staff's Memorandum, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order approving the following Spire East and Spire West WNAR tariff sheets, as substituted on Monday, September 20, 2021:

on October 1, 2021.

DATE: September 23, 2021

On September 1, 2021, Spire filed two tariff sheets to adjust its weather normalization adjustment rider (WNAR) rates with an effective date of October 1, 2021. On September 10, 2021, Staff filed its recommendation recommending rejection of Spire's proposed tariff sheets. On September 14, 2021, the Commission ordered Spire to file a response to Staff's recommendation by September 20, 2021. The same order allowed for Staff or any other entity wishing to reply to Spire's response by September 21, 2021. On September 20, 2021, Spire revised its application and filed two substitute tariff sheets.

These tariff sheets incorporate the differences between normal and actual weather for the billing months of February 2021 through July 2021. Spire's current and proposed rates are included in Table 1 below.

Table 1: Current and Proposed WNAR Rates by District and Class.

District	Current	Proposed
Spire East	0.01006	0.00190
Spire West	0.01059	0.00583

Because the previous periods generally experienced colder weather than normal in Spire's rate districts, mainly due to the February cold snap, the proposed rates are a smaller positive rate in this filing. This means a residential customer in the Spire East district that used 100 ccf in a given billing month would see a line item charge of \$0.19 in their bill, which is an \$0.82 reduction in their bill from the current WNAR rate, and a residential customer in the Spire West district would see a line item charge of \$0.58 in their bill, which is an \$0.48 reduction in their bill from the current WNAR rate.

## **Staff Recommendation**

Staff has reviewed the following tariff sheets, as substituted on September 21, 2021, and recommends approval of the following tariff sheets to go into effect for service on and after October 1, 2021, the requested effective date:
