ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF SHEETS

Issue Date: January 20, 2022

Effective Date: January 20, 2022

On December 23, 2021, Spire Missouri Inc., filed an application requesting that the Commission authorize changes to the Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharges (ISRS).

Also on December 23, 2021, Spire Missouri filed tariff revisions which are marked as Tracking No. YG-2022-0192. This tariff sheet, applicable to both Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West, bears an effective date of January 22, 2022.

Section 393.1015.2(3), RSMo (Supp. 2021), requires that the Commission act on the applications no later than 180 days after filing, which is June 21, 2022.¹

Section 393.150.1 RSMo (2016), authorizes the Commission to suspend the January 22, 2022, effective date of proposed tariff sheets for 120 days, which would be May 22, 2022. To conduct a hearing, the section allows the Commission to suspend the effective date a further period not to exceed six months. The Commission's experience demonstrates that a full hearing cannot be concluded within 120 days, so the Commission will suspend the tariff sheets for an additional thirty days, until to June 21, 2022, which is also the statutory deadline for Commission action.²

To provide sufficient time to determine if Spire Missouri's proposed tariff sheets are just and reasonable,³ the Commission will suspend the tariff sheets for 120 days plus thirty days beyond their effective date, or until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed by Spire Missouri Inc. for its Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West service territories on December 23, 2021, marked as Tariff Tracking No. YG-2022-0192, is suspended until June 21, 2022, or until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. This order is effective when issued.
