ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET FILED IN COMPLIANCE
WITH COMMISSION’S ORDER

Issue Date: November 28, 2007

Effective Date: December 1, 2007

On October 12, 2007, Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks–L&P, submitted a proposed tariff sheet that contains a quarterly cost adjustment to allow customer rates to change with fuel cost changes. The tariff sheet was filed pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in Case No. HR-2005-0450. Aquila’s tariff sheet, Tariff No. YH-2008-0235, has a proposed effective date of December 1, 2007.

On November 15, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a recommendation. Staff states that it has reviewed Tariff No. YH-2008-0235 and is of the opinion that it has been calculated in accordance with the provisions of the Quarterly Cost Adjustment Rider tariff sheet and complies with the Commission’s order in Case No. HR-2005-0450. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheet to become effective on December 1, 2007. No objections to the tariff were filed.

The Commission has reviewed Aquila’s tariff sheet and Staff’s verified recommendation, which is hereby admitted into evidence. Based on these filings, the

Commission finds that the tariff sheet is in compliance with the Commission's previous order and shall be approved as ordered below.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Tariff No. YH-2008-0235, submitted on October 12, 2007, is hereby approved for steam service rendered on or after December 1, 2007. The tariff sheet approved is:
