ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

On September 12, 2008, the Commission gave notice of this case and set certain procedural dates, including an early prehearing conference and a filing date for a proposed procedural schedule.


On October 22, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed a status report and a motion for additional time. Staff relates that the parties, including the intervenors, began discussing a procedural schedule at the early prehearing held on October 15, 2008. The parties have continued discussions but as yet have reached neither agreement nor a clear impasse in arriving at a consensus concerning a schedule. Staff therefore requests an extension of time, until October 29, 2008, to file a proposed procedural schedule or schedules. Staff states that Aquila, Inc., and the Office of the Public Counsel expressed agreement to this request, and that no party opposed it during discussions.

The Commission has considered the Staff's report and motion and will grant the requested extension of time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's Motion for Additional Time is granted.
2. No later than October 29, 2008, the parties shall either jointly or separately file proposed procedural schedules.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
