The only other thing I want to mention while we're on the record is the test year, Liberty proposed test year, historical test year ending June 30, 2017, updated through December 31, 2017, and trued-up through March 31 of 2018. Staff and Public Counsel have responded indicating that they are in concurrence with that. Anyone else wish to be heard on that? Okay. I will establish that as the test year for this case then and I'll issue an order when I get back upstairs to let the public know about that.
