**COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF STAFF RECOMMEDATION**

Comes Now Jefferson County Public Sewer District (“JCPSD”), by and through its counsel, in response to the Missouri Public Service Commission’s *Order Directing Filing*, and states as follows:

1. On January 10, 2018, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its *Staff Recommendation*, recommending the Commission approve the transfer of assets from P.C.B., Inc. (“PCB”) to JCPSD as requested, with six additional recommendations.

2. JCPSD fully supports Staff’s recommendations. JCPSD requests that, based on the *Staff Recommendation*, the Commission approve the transfer of assets from PCB to JCPSD at its earliest possible convenience.

3. Out of an abundance of caution, JCPSD notes that since PCB is now in receivership, it will likely fall to Utility Management of Missouri, LLC (“UMM”), in its capacity as court-appointed receiver for PCB to provide the recommended notices and reports specified in recommendations 2., 3., and 6. JCPSD will work with and support UMM in fulfilling the recommended conditions.

WHEREFORE, for the above stated reasons, Jefferson County Public Sewer District supports the *Staff Recommendation* and requests the Commission approve the Joint Application at its earliest possible convenience.
