ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Background

On June 18, 2008,¹ the Commission's Staff filed a request to amend the procedural schedule set in this matter. Currently, the evidentiary hearing is set for October 20 through October 24, and October 27 through October 31. Because of other case conflicts, Staff has requested to amend this schedule to eliminate the days of October 30-31. Staff states that has discussed this proposed amendment with all of the other parties to this action and that all parties have agreed to the proposal.

Because all of the parties have agreed that the evidentiary hearing can be completed with the revision proposed by Staff, the Commission finds the proposal to be reasonable and shall grant it. The Commission cautions the parties; however, that if any time constraints develop during the evidentiary hearing, the parties, and the parties' witnesses, should be prepared to stay late into the evening hours in order to complete the hearing on schedule.
