On January 31, 2020, Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. (Veolia) filed tariff sheets (Tracking No. HY-2020-0123) to revise its Production Adjustment Cost Clause (PACC) rates for steam service. The tariff sheets have a proposed effective date of April 1, 2020. The Commission will direct notice to be provided of Veolia's PACC filing. The Commission will also direct the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission to file a recommendation on Veolia's tariff sheets. A deadline will be set for any other party to file a response to the tariff sheets or Staff's recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on all parties to Veolia's last general rate case, File No. HR-2018-0341.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission for Jackson County, Missouri.
- 3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly representing Jackson County, Missouri, and to the media serving Jackson County, Missouri.

- 4. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than February 21, 2019. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or with the Secretary of the Commission.
- 5. Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Veolia's revised tariff sheets no later than March 5, 2020.
- 6. Any party wishing to comment on the tariff sheets or Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than March 16, 2020.
 - 7. This order shall be effective when issued.
