ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On September 22, 2006, The Innsbrook Corporation filed a complaint against AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. After several rounds of pleadings, the Staff of the Commission filed a Recommendation on January 24. Staff asks the Commission to set a prehearing conference. The Commission will grant Staff's request.

At the conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss what issues they believe the Commission should resolve. In addition, they should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. The parties should also be prepared to name the witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. Also, the parties should be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A prehearing conference will be held on February 27, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. The parties shall file a joint proposed procedural schedule or, in the alternative, a pleading informing the Commission how they wish to proceed, no later than March 6, 2007.
3. This order shall become effective on February 6, 2007.
