ORDER APPROVING AMEREN MISSOURI'S PGA TARIFF

Issue Date: October 26, 2022 Effective Date: November 1, 2022

On October 14, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a proposed tariff sheet to reflect changes in the company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factor as a result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas. The tariff sheet bears an effective date of November 1, 2022.

Ameren Missouri proposes changes in PGA rates for customer classes as follows:

- The change in the Total PGA rate applicable to the Company's service areas will increase to 94.70¢/Ccf from 93.04¢/Ccf for firm sales customers.
- The interruptible sales customers' PGA will increase to 67.76¢/Ccf from 65.39¢/Ccf.
- The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf

The Commission directed an expedited recommendation and other responses to Ameren Missouri's proposed tariff sheet be filed no later than October 24, 2022. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) timely filed its recommendation. No other responses were received.

In its recommendation, Staff stated that the rates in the proposed tariff sheets, Tracking No. YG-2022-0067, were calculated in conformance with Ameren Missouri's

PGA clause. Staff states that the rate changes proposed in the present PGA tariff filing should be made on an interim basis, subject to refund.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheets conform to Ameren Missouri's Commission-approved PGA clause. In addition, because Ameren Missouri's PGA clause allows for PGA change filings to take effect after ten business days, good cause has been shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo, to permit the tariff and this order to become effective on less than 30-days' notice. The Commission concludes the proposed tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on November 1, 2022, on an interim basis, subject to refund.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet, assigned Tracking No. YG-2022-0067, is approved to become effective on November 1, 2022, on an interim basis and subject to refund:

- 2. Staff shall file the results of its ACA review and recommendations no later than December 15, 2023.
