### ORDER APPROVING AMEREN MISSOURI'S PGA TARIFF

Issue Date: June 23, 2022 Effective Date: July 1, 2022

On June 15, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a proposed tariff sheet to reflect changes in the company's Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) factor as a result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas for the period July 2022 through November 2022. The tariff sheet does not change Ameren Missouri's Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors. The tariff sheet bears an effective date of July 1, 2022.

Ameren Missouri proposes changes in RPGA rates for customer classes as follows:

- For Residential and General Service customers, the Total PGA rate filed by will increase to \$.9304 per one hundred cubic feet (Ccf) from the current Total PGA rate of \$.7712 per Ccf. The Residential and General Service Total PGA rate increase is \$.1592 per Ccf, a 21% increase.
- The Interruptible sales customers' Total PGA rate will increase to \$.6539
   per Ccf from the current Total PGA rate of \$.5200 per Ccf which is an increase of \$.1339 per Ccf, a 26% increase.

The Transportation rate remains the same at \$0 per Ccf.

The Commission directed an expedited recommendation and other responses to Ameren Missouri's proposed tariff sheet be filed no later than June 21, 2022. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation on June 17, 2022. No other responses were received.

In its recommendation, Staff stated that the rates in the proposed tariff sheets, Tracking No. JG-2022-0278, were calculated in conformance with Ameren Missouri's PGA clause.

Staff states that the present case, File No. GR-2022-0351, was established to track Ameren Missouri's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2021-2022 ACA filing. File No. GR-2021-0291 was established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2020-2021 ACA filing. The rate changes proposed in the present case should be made on an interim basis, subject to refund, and pending final Commission decisions in File Nos. GR-2022-0351 and GR-2021-0291.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheets conform to Ameren Missouri's Commission-approved PGA clause. In addition, because Ameren Missouri's PGA clause allows for PGA change filings to take effect after ten business days, good cause has been shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo, to permit the tariff and this order to become effective on less than 30-days' notice. The Commission concludes the proposed tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on July 1, 2022, on an interim basis, subject to refund, and pending final Commission decision in File Nos. GR-2022-0351 and GR-2021-0291.

1. The following tariff sheets, assigned Tracking No. JG-2022-0278, are approved on an interim basis and subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in File Nos. GR-2022-0351 and GR-2021-0291:
