- JUDGE STEARLEY: All right, we will go
- 3 ahead and go on the record. Good evening. This evening is
- 4 Tuesday, September 1st, 2009. The Missouri Public Service
- 5 Commission has set this time to hold a public hearing in
- 6 file No. GR-2009-0355. Missouri Gas Energy is seeking a
- 7 general rate increase for its natural gas service in
- 8 Missouri. My name is Harold Stearley, and I am the senior
- 9 regulatory law judge that will preside over the
- 10 commission's hearing. Commissioner Jarrett is present on
- 11 site in Warrensburg, Missouri.
- 12 Although we have no other commissions present
- 13 for the live hearing, they will be viewing the transcripts
- 14 and recordings of this hearing, and any testimony that's
- 15 offered will be taken into consideration and made part of
- 16 the official record of this case. This is an official
- 17 hearing, so any statements or testimony given tonight will
- 18 need to be sworn testimony, and I will swear the witnesses
- 19 in, and they will give their testimony under oath.
- 20 Any person, once I ask them a couple of
- 21 preliminary questions, may give their statement, and then
- 22 the attorneys that are present or the various parties may
- 23 have questions for that witness. I may have questions or
- 24 Commissioner Jarrett may have questions. So those people
- 25 who are speaking tonight, please remain until you are

- 1 excused.
- 2 Are there any questions about the procedure
- 3 that we're going to follow tonight? Hearing none, I am
- 4 going to begin by taking entries of appearance by counsel,
- 5 starting with Missouri Gas Energy.
- 6 MR. SWEARINGEN: Jim Swearingen here in
- 7 Jefferson City, Missouri, on behalf of Missouri Gas Energy.
- 8 MR. JACOBS: For the company, Todd Jacobs,
- 9 Missouri Gas Energy, 3420 Broadway, Kansas City, Missouri.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Jacobs.
- 11 The staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission?
- 12 MS. SHEMWELL: Lera Shemwell representing
- 13 the staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission.
- 14 JUDGE STEARLEY: The Office of Public
- 15 Counsel?
- 16 MR. POSTON: Marc Poston appearing for the
- 17 Office of the Public Counsel.
- 18 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Poston.
- 19 Are any of counsel here representing any of the intervenors
- 20 in this case this evening?
- 21 MR. OCHOA: I don't see any, your Honor.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well, I'm
- 23 assuming I haven't missed anyone yet. Commissioner
- 24 Jarrett, would you like to make some opening remarks before
- 25 we begin?

1 COMMISSIONER JARRETT: Yes. Thank you,

- 2 Judge. Can you hear me?
- JUDGE STEARLEY: Yes, I can.
- 4 COMMISSIONER JARRETT: All right. I am
- 5 Terry Jarrett. I am a commissioner with the Public Service
- 6 Commission. It's a great pleasure to be back in
- 7 Warrensburg.
- 8 In 1982, this institution, either in its
- 9 infinite wisdom or infinite stupidity, awarded me a
- 10 Bachelor's degree, so I am a proud graduate and alumni of
- 11 UCM, glad to be back on campus, and I want to thank
- 12 everybody for coming tonight.
- I wanted to let you know on behalf of myself
- 14 and all the commissioners, we view these public meetings as
- 15 very important. The testimony that you give in these cases
- 16 are important to us, and we certainly take them very
- 17 seriously. So again, thanks for being here, and I'm glad
- 18 to be here and look forward to hearing your testimony.
- 19 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Commissioner
- 20 Jarrett. I might like to also extend our thanks to the
- 21 host at Warrensburg. Without the opportunity to be able to
- 22 use the video conferencing or web casting, we wouldn't be
- 23 able to reach out to so many people in the public to take
- 24 your comments. Mr. Ochoa, do we have a witness list?
- 25 MR. OCHOA: We do, your Honor. We had one

- 1 gentleman that signed the list, and he has informed me that
- 2 he's changed his mind, and he does not the wish to testify.
- 3 Is there anyone that's wants to testify?
- 4 JUDGE STEARLEY: I hope I haven't scared
- 5 anyone off. We do have this testimony given under oath.
- 6 It's not a very formal proceeding, and we certainly would
- 7 welcome any comments from any of the people attending there
- 8 today.
- 9 Second chance here. Anyone like to speak?
- 10 Well, I'm not hearing anyone volunteering here.
- 11 I would like to remind everyone that they can
- 12 also make comments by calling the Public Service
- 13 Commission. They can submit them in writing by mail. They
- 14 can submit them in writing by our web page. And I believe
- 15 the staff on site has all that contact information. They
- 16 can also submit comments through the Office of Public
- 17 Counsel. I know Mr. Poston is present there.
- 18 The evidentiary hearing set for this case is
- 19 currently scheduled for October 26th through 30th and the
- 20 week also of November 2nd through the 6th. If people wish
- 21 to monitor that hearing, they can tune in on that. That
- 22 also will be web cast.
- There won't be a decision immediately
- 24 following that hearing. There will be a time period in
- 25 which the commission takes briefs from the parties and

- 1 thoroughly considers all the evidence. So this case will
- 2 remain open for public comments throughout this time
- 3 period, until the close of evidence.
- 4 I'll do a third call. Would anyone like to
- 5 offer any statements this evening? Seeing none,
- 6 Commissioner Jarrett, would you like to make a closing
- 7 remark?
- 8 COMMISSIONER JARRETT: I would just say
- 9 thank you, Judge, for that fine soliloquy on how folks can
- 10 comment, and I know that anyone watching on the web cast or
- 11 here tonight will take advantage of that if they so desire.
- 12 JUDGE STEARLEY: We will go off the
- 13 record. People in attendance are certainly welcome to
- 14 speak to the party representatives there, and I'm sure
- 15 Commissioner Jarrett will entertain any private comments
- 16 from you.
- 17 I would like to thank you all for attending,
- and the local public hearing in GR-2009-0355 is hereby
- 19 adjourned. Thank you all very much.
- 20 (Hearing adjourned.)
