

**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT OF TARIFFS**

**COMES NOW** Granite Telecommunications, LLC ("Granite" or "Company"), by and through its attorneys, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16) and 4 CSR 240-2.065(2), and the Order Granting Staff Motion in Case No. TO-98-329, and requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") expedite the approval of its tariffs, for good cause shown, and permit the Company to make effective on May 1, 2005, the tariffs filed on April 21, 2005, in this proceeding. In support of this Motion, Granite respectfully states:


1. Simultaneously with the filing of this Motion, Granite is filing the tariffs which are designed to modify its tariffs to implement provisions of 4 CSR 240-31.065 related to the collection of surcharges from end-user subscribers for the Missouri Universal Service Fund. The tariffs have an issue date of April 21, 2005, and an effective date of May 21, 2005.

2. In order that authorized tariffs may become effective by the commencement of Granite's May billing cycle, Granite respectfully requests that the Commission issue its Order Approving Tariffs and approve the tariffs to go into effect on May 1, 2005. This will permit Granite to implement the MoUSF surcharges in an orderly fashion with its May billing cycle. There will be no negative effect upon the Company's customers or the general public if the Commission acts by the date requested since the Company authorized to implement these

surcharges pursuant to 4 CSR 240-31.065. In addition, the Company is filing this pleading as soon as it could have since the pleading is being filed simultaneously with the proposed tariffs.

**WHEREFORE**, Granite Telecommunications, LLC, respectfully requests that the Commission authorize its tariffs to go into effect on an expedited basis and become effective on May 1, 2005.

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
