## **ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On July 2, 2008<sup>1</sup>, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (hereafter "MGE"), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2007, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. After MGE and the Staff of the Commission filed a Stipulation and Agreement on September 16<sup>2</sup>, the Commission issued an Order Approving Adjusted ISRS Rates on September 18.

That order rejected MGE's initial ISRS tariff, and allowed MGE to file a tariff to recover the ISRS costs as agreed upon by MGE and Staff. In an attempt to comply with the Commission's September 18 order, MGE filed a tariff sheet on September 19, which bears an effective date of October 18. However, MGE also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment, asking the Commission to approve the tariff sheet on October 1.

- The Staff of the Commission shall file either its Recommendation or a Status Report no later than September 24, 2008.
- 2. Any objections to the Motion for Expedited Treatment or the tariff sheet itself shall be filed no later than September 24, 2008.
  - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
