ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On July 2, 2008, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (hereafter "MGE"), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1009, 393.1012, and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2007, requesting that the Commission authorize it to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge. Section 393.1015.2(3) requires that the Commission act on the application no later than 120 days after it was filed. That means the Commission must issue an order regarding the application with an effective date no later than October 30, 2008.

Along with its application, MGE filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge. Unless the Commission suspends that tariff, it will become effective on August 1, 2008.

So that it can consider MGE's implementing tariff and the underlying application, that tariff shall be suspended until October 30, 2008, unless sooner approved by the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed by Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, on July 2, 2008, and assigned tariff number YG-2009-0008, is suspended until October 30, 2008. The tariff suspended is:
