On July 18, 2008, Laclede Gas Company (hereafter "Laclede") filed the above-titled application. Laclede wishes to abandon its propane service to the above-referenced areas. To that end, Laclede has reached agreement with AmeriGas Partners, L.P. (hereafter "AmeriGas") to purchase Laclede's assets used to serve those areas, so that AmeriGas can serve to those areas instead.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed 20 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for leave to intervene. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of Jefferson County. In addition, the Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Jefferson County and to the members of the Missouri General Assembly representing Jefferson County.
