**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF**

On January 15, 2010, Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1009, 393.1012, and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2009, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 2.080 and 3.265, requesting that the Commission authorize it to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS"). Section 393.1015.2(3) requires that the Commission act on Laclede's application no later than 120 days after the petition was filed; therefore, the Commission must issue an order regarding the application that is effective no later than May 15, 2010.<sup>1</sup>

Concurrently with its application, Laclede filed a tariff to implement the changes to the ISRS. Unless the Commission acts to suspend that tariff, it will become effective on March 31, 2010. In order for the Commission to have adequate time to consider Laclede's application the tariff will be suspended.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The tariff sheet filed by Laclede Gas Company on January 15, 2010, and assigned tariff number YG-2010-0455, is suspended until May 15, 2010. The tariff suspended is:

2. This order shall become effective on immediately upon issuance.
