**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND
TO STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION**

On July 16, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed an application and petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1009, 393.1012, and 393.1015, RSMo Supp. 2012, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 2.080 and 3.265, requesting that the Commission authorize it to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”). On September 13, 2013, the Commission’s Staff recommended that the amount Ameren Missouri should be allowed to recover through its ISRS be decreased from \$1,337,273, to \$1,266,546. The Commission will require Ameren Missouri and any other interested parties to respond to Staff’s recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and any other party wishing to respond to Staff’s recommendation filed on September 13, 2013, shall do so no later than September 23, 2013.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
