ORDER CANCELLING TRUE-UP

The Commission is granting the motion to modify the procedural schedule by cancelling the true-up hearing and related procedural requirements (“motion”). The motion is a part of an unopposed partial settlement,¹ and is conditioned on the terms of that partial settlement, but applies to any true-up for any issue.² The Commission has this day incorporated the terms of the partial settlement into an order.³ Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion described in the body of this order is granted, the procedural schedule is modified by deleting all procedural requirements related to the true-up hearing, and the true-up hearing is cancelled.
