**NOTICE OF HEARINGS AND ORDER SETTING CONFERENCE DATE,
DIRECTING NOTICE OF ACTION, AND GOVERNING FILINGS**

Summit Natural Gas of Missouri Inc. filed proposed tariff sheets (“tariff”) on January 2¹ seeking a 26.5% revenue increase in the amount of \$7,472,131.² The Commission suspended the tariff until December 1, initiating a contested case.³ Therefore, Commission will direct notice of this action, set dates for hearings and a conference, and provide for certain filings.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Notice of this Action. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve a copy of this notice and order upon the county commission of each county within Summit Natural Gas of Missouri Inc.’s service area. The Commission’s Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Summit Natural Gas of Missouri Inc.’s service area and the news media serving Summit Natural Gas of Missouri Inc.’s service area.

2. Notice of Hearings and Order Setting Conference. The Commission will convene evidentiary hearings and a conference as follows.

Each hearing or conference will convene in Room 310, Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. That building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. c. Staff shall coordinate, and jointly file on behalf of all parties in agreement, proposed orders:

- i. Setting a procedural schedule. Any proposed order setting a procedural schedule shall include proposed cut-off dates for discovery service, responses, conferences, and rulings.
- ii. Governing discovery.
- iii. Governing prepared testimony.
- iv. Setting local public hearings.

4. Effective Date of this Notice and Order. This notice and order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
