**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

Issue Date: March 5, 2013

Effective Date: March 7, 2014

On February 21, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren") filed tariff sheets proposed to become effective March 7, 2014. The tariff sheets reflect changes in Ameren's Purchased Gas Adjustment ("PGA") as a result of estimated changes in the cost of natural gas. The tariff sheets reflect no change in transportation charges. For all service areas except Rolla, Ameren's filing will increase the interruptible PGA factor to \$0.4917 from \$0.4521. This represents an increase of \$0.0396 per Ccf. For all service areas except Rolla, Ameren's filing will increase the residential PGA factor for the first 30 Ccf to \$0.23785 per Ccf from \$0.1778, and for all other Ccf to \$1.0330 per Ccf from \$0.9730. This represents an increase of \$0.0600 per Ccf. For the Rolla System service area (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville), Ameren's filing will increase the interruptible PGA factor to \$0.5042 from \$0.4646, the residential PGA factor for the first 30 Ccf to \$0.4445 per Ccf from \$0.3845, and for all other Ccf to \$0.4445 per Ccf from \$0.3845. This represents an increase of \$0.0600 per Ccf.

The Commission's Staff filed its recommendation on February 21, 2014. Staff recommends the rates be approved on an interim basis, subject to refund pending final Commission decision in File Nos. GR-2014-0238 and GR-2014-0061.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet conforms to Ameren's Commission-approved PGA Clause. In addition, because Ameren's PGA Clause allows for PGA change filings to take effect on 10 days' notice, good cause has been shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000., to permit the tariff to become effective on less than 30 days' notice. The Commission concludes that the proposed tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on March 7, 2014, on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decision in File Nos. GR-2014-0238 and GR-2014-0061.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The proposed tariff sheets filed on February 21, 2014 by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri assigned tracking no. JG-2014-0328 and bearing an effective date of March 7, 2014, are approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decision in File Nos. GR-2014-0238 and GR-2014-0061.
