Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, has applied to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS) to recover an additional \$1,418,961 of annual revenue. On December 17, 2007, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission to approve MGE's ISRS for a reduced amount of \$1,339,878.

The Commission will provide the other parties an opportunity to respond to Staff's recommendation if they wish to do so.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party that wants to respond to Staff's Recommendation shall do so no later than December 27, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on December 18, 2007.
