**THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION’S OBJECTION  
TO THE SECOND NONUNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND  
AGREEMENT**

COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Conservation and within the seven days allotted by rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2)(B), hereby objects to the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement of Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Public Service Commission, Renew Missouri, and MIEC filed on September 24, 2018. The Missouri Department of Conservation opposes this settlement agreement on the following grounds:

**Paragraph 10 – Wildlife**

- The Second Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement does not include any operational measures to lessen the impact on wildlife or monitoring provisions to inform the Department, the Commission and the public about the impact of the project. Such measures and provisions would ensure the Department is able to fulfill its Constitutional mission to control, manage, restore, conserve and regulate
