ORDER REGARDING STATUS REPORT AND DIRECTING FILING

On March 5, 2004, the Commission issued its Report and Order approving Laclede Gas Company's application regarding the establishment of requirements for the final phase of Laclede's unprotected steel main replacement program. The Commission's order modified the replacement program by reducing the annual replacement requirements for unprotected steel mains that meet the criteria in paragraphs (15)(E)3 through (15)(E)6 of Rule 4 CSR 240-40.030, from an average of 20,000 feet per year to an average annual rate of 10,000 feet, until all remaining mains identified by this section have been replaced. Ordered paragraph 4 of the Report and Order directed the Staff of the Commission to file annual status reports regarding Laclede's progress in the unprotected steel main replacement program, with the first report due no later than May 5, 2004.

On April 12, 2004, Staff filed its first annual Status Report. Staff noted that during Fiscal Year 2003, Laclede eliminated 10,532 feet of unprotected steel main that met the criteria of paragraphs 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(E)3 through (15)(E)6.

On April 15, 2005, Staff filed its second annual Status Report. Staff indicates that during the Fiscal Year 2004, Laclede eliminated 10,300 feet of unprotected steel main that met the criteria of 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(E)3 through (15)(E)6. Staff notes that this represents annual average rate of 10,416 feet for Fiscal Years 2003 and 2004, which exceeds the required annual average rate of 10,000 feet. Staff further states that Laclede has notified Staff that 102,562 feet of unprotected steel main remained at the end of Fiscal Year 2004.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's Status Report and concludes that Staff should file its next annual report no later than May 4, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That no later than May 4, 2006, the Staff of the Commission shall file its next annual Status Report.
2. That this order shall become effective on May 3, 2005.
