APPLICATION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER FOR FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Comes now Granite Telecommunications, Inc. ("Granite"), and pursuant to 4 C.S.R. 240-2.085, moves for a protective order seeking confidential treatment of financial statements filed by Granite with its Application for a Certificate of Service Authority. In support of the Application, Granite states the following:


1. Granite incorporates by reference relevant information from its Application for a Certificate Authority, filed with the Commission on the same date as this captioned Application.
2. As part of its Application for a Certificate of Service Authority, Granite filed certain financial statements as Exhibit F to that Application. Granite requests that the Commission designate those financial statements as confidential and prohibit their dissemination to members of the public, in light of the competitively sensitive information contained in those financial statements.
3. Granite believes that competitors in the telecommunications industry could derive from the financial statements information unfairly useful to their competitive efforts. Disclosure of the information to the public and to Granite's competitors could damage Granite's ability to compete in the Missouri marketplace. In addition, Granite is not aware that the information contained in Exhibit F can be found in any other public documents. As such, Granite requests

that the Commission grant confidential status of Exhibit F of its Application for a Certificate of Service Authority.

Wherefore, Granite Telecommunications, LLC requests that the Commission grant its Application for a protective order seeking confidential treatment of the financial statements contained in Exhibit F of its Application for a Certificate of Service Authority.



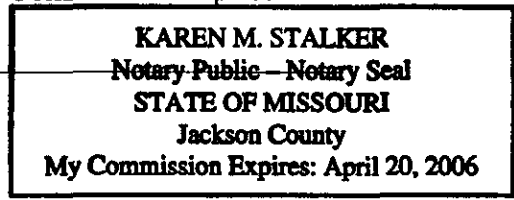
