1 PROCEEDINGS 2 JUDGE HATCHER: Let's go on the record. First I would ask that everyone please 3 mute themselves unless they are speaking. That'll 4 5 cut down on the noise level and also prevent any audio feedback. 6 7 Today is June 24th, 2021, and the Missouri Public Service Commission has set this time 8 9 for a local public hearing in Case No. GR-2021-0108 10 which is captioned as In the Matter of Spire 11 Missouri, Inc. doing business as Spire's Request for 12 Authority to Implement a General Rate Increase for Natural Gas Service Provided in the Company's 13 Missouri Service Areas. 14 15 The Commission has scheduled this public 16 hearing to give members of the public a chance to 17 comment about Spire's application. The Missouri 18 Public Service Commission regulates the rates charged 19 by public utility companies in Missouri to ensure 20 that those rates are just and reasonable. The 21 Commission also regulates the quality of service and 22 the safety of the operations of public utilities. 23 The commission is made up of five commissioners. The 24 commissioners are appointed by the governor and 25 confirmed by the Senate. The commissioners employ a

staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial
 analysts, and other specialists in the field of
 utility regulation.

My name is Charles Hatcher, and I am a regulatory law judge and will be presiding over this hearing. With me tonight are Commissioners Kolkmeyer and Commissioner Coleman.

Again, this is an official hearing of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the statements and testimony of witnesses will be recorded by the court reporter and must be given under oath. We'll begin our hearing by asking counsel to please enter their appearance for the record. Spire, please go ahead.
