**NOTICE CLOSING CASE**

Date Issued: March 30, 2009

On May 25, 2007, in Kansas City, while Missouri Gas Energy personnel were excavating to repair a detected gas leak, a natural gas main ruptured. The Staff of the Commission filed an Incident Report and MGE and Staff thereafter entered into a settlement agreement, which was approved by the Commission on March 23, 2008.

As part of the Agreement, MGE proposed to replace during 2008 all 24-inch diameter cast iron mains operating above 25 psig. In approving the agreement, the Commission directed its Staff to determine whether MGE had replaced, by December 31, 2008, the above-described mains.

On March 26, 2009, Staff reported that MGE has complied with the Order approving the Stipulation and Agreement. Although a similar report is due in March of 2012, with regard to 16-inch cast iron mains, this case will be closed until that time.
