On October 31, 2016, Laclede Gas Company filed an application asking the Commission to authorize it to sell a section of natural gas pipeline to an affiliated company, Spire Pipeline, Inc. Along with its request for authority to sell the pipeline, Laclede asks for a variance from the asymmetrical pricing standards of the Commission's affiliate transaction rule.

The Commission finds that notice of the application should be given to the general public and interested parties and a date for intervention of proper parties should be set. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the County Commission of St. Louis County. In addition, the Commission's public information officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving St. Louis County and to the members of the General Assembly representing St. Louis County.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention, and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary for a determination on the application.¹
