I have discovered what appears to be a leak at Larimoer Ave. and Coalbank Rd. (see photos.) Water stays in this puddle some times for days after it rains when all other rain has dried up. Also the dirt on the south side of Coal Bank remains wet and muddy for many days. Recently just days ago it rained, then we had a sunny day of over 70 degree weather the puddle completely dried up, The next day was also nice then without any more precipitation water returned to this puddle again. Water also seems to be flowing out of the ground and into the storm drain across the street in front of the Citgo Gas Station.

It appears nothing has been done at this location.

Please test the pipes in this area with the ultrasonic test equipment.
