## **ORDER ESTABLISHING ENDING ACA BALANCE**

Issue Date: January 19, 2022

Effective Date: February 18, 2022

The Commission opened this case to receive the 2019-2020 Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filings of Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty (Liberty). The Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation regarding that ACA filing on December 15, 2021. Staff's recommendation and memorandum indicated Staff had completed an audit of billed revenues and actual gas costs for the period September 1, 2019, through August 31, 2020, that were included in Liberty's computation of its ACA balances.

Staff's recommendation and memorandum sets out the ending balance contained in Liberty's ACA filing, and recommended some monetary adjustments to that ending balance. Staff also offered some non-monetary recommendations regarding Liberty's policies and practices. Liberty responded to Staff's recommendations on January 11, 2022, accepting Staff's monetary and non-monetary recommendations.

After reviewing Staff's recommendations and Liberty's responses, the Commission concludes that Staff's recommended ending ACA balances should be accepted as a resolution of Liberty's 2019-2020 ACA audit.
